

Delaware Township Environmental Commission
Recycling at Township Garage

Where? 816 Sergeantsville Road (aka Route 523)
South of Sergeantsville, past the Fire House on right side
(towards Stockton)

When? During regular business hours, generally 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

What?

Paper and Cardboard red container, upright with a door

Accepted: Flattened cardboard, magazines, junk mail and other paper, newspapers
No need to tie, but try to contain it in some way, so it does not blow all over.

NOT accepted – Styrofoam® and plastic of any type. Please!

When you have an object that is packed in Styrofoam – please remove the Styrofoam before placing the cardboard in the container and discard in your own trash.

Aluminum, Glass, and Tin red container – horizontal with sliding doors

Accepted: aluminum, glass, and tin (bi-metal)

Please rinse food containers, food is considered a contaminant and could cause our recycling to be rejected.

NOT accepted – Styrofoam® and plastic of any type. Please!

No planting pots, no plastic liquid containers, toys, etc!

Please – no plastic of any type! (also a contaminant)

If your method of transportation of this material is a plastic bag, please empty it from plastic bags and take those bags with you. Please close the sliding doors when done.
