Water samples must then be returned on 9/23 from 7-9:00am at the Delaware DPW garage

Basic Kit \$60

Basic kit includes tests for coliform bacteria, E.coli, and nitrate. Test every year for these indicators of sanitary quality.

Arsenic \$35

Testing for this naturally occurring carcinogen is recommended every 3-5 years.

Lead \$25

All homes built before 1987 should have drinking water tested for lead.

Volatile Organic Compounds \$95

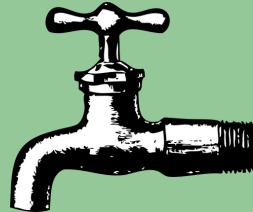
Can cause liver, nervous system disorders, high blood pressure, anemia and cancer. Test every 5-7 years.

Radon \$50

Radon in well water is a common issue. Test at least once.

Gross Alpha \$80

Gross Alpha is a test for uranium and radium. Test at least once.
(other testing options are available)
