#### **Resolution 23-88**

#### Resolution 23-90

**WHEREAS**, the Association of New Jersey Environmental Commissions (ANJEC) recently announced a municipal grant program, entitled 2023 Open Space Stewardship Projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the eligible uses for the grant monies include funding for environmental commission projects related to conservation easement inventory, monitoring, outreach, and education; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Delaware Environmental Commission is responsible for inventorying, conducting inspections and education on conservation easements; and

**WHEREAS,** the financial assistance offered by the ANJEC grant will enable the Township to offset some of the costs associated with inventory, monitoring, outreach, and education of conservation easements; and

**THEREFORE**, the Township Committee of Delaware Township has determined that the Township of Delaware should apply for the aforementioned Grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, formally authorize the submission of an application for the aforementioned ANJEC Grant for an amount not to exceed \$1,500; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** the Environmental Commission's Grant Subcommittee and the Township CFO/Administrator are authorized to submit such paperwork as required on the Township's behalf for this grant program.

Kathy Kats (Resident) makes mention of her happiness regarding the new park planner. Advises that the Environmental Commission has submitted a plan for flood control in the parks, along with ideas for pollination gardens and other native habitat improvements.

Jess Stahl (Resident) poses a question regarding the appointments in the Recreation Commission.

Peter McCrohan (Resident of Worman Road) raises concern regarding multiple trees down on Worman Road. He has reached out for guidance from the local utility companies with no plan on rectifying the situation. Mr. McCrohan is advised by the Township Committee to provide a list of trees/locations to Susan Lockwood (DPW Liaison) for further assessment & discussion.

At this time the Township Deputy Clerk Taylor Gribbin covering meeting was asked to leave for Executive Session.
