

## PennEast Files with FERC: What Can I DO?

- PE has entered into what's known as a pre-filing application. That means that they have entered into a period of time where FERC will help them prepare their documentation so that when they officially file (sometime next year), they are more likely to pass muster and get the certificate to operate.
- The next step for all of us is to subscribe to FERC to receive notifications about PE's pre-filing status. I will detail the steps for doing that below, but once you are registered and subscribed with FERC, you will receive all notifications related to their docket number, AND you will receive notification of when they do the official filing, at which point you will receive a NEW docket number. That's when you file to be an intervener and are able to partake in the public comments period.
- Steps to register and subscribe with FERC.
  - Go here and click the icon for eRegister

  - Go All The Way Through registration as a FULL registration  
(If you don't go all the way through the FULL registration, but rather stop at the partial registration, you won't be able to subscribe)
  - The full registration is a bit weird because the final page asks for an alternate's name and address in the event that you can't be contacted, but it also says you don't need to do this if you're a private citizen. In my case, I wasn't able to complete a full registration without providing an alternate's info, even though I'm a private citizen. So I used my own name again and gave a secondary email address and my other phone number, and it worked.
  - At this point, you will be given a notice that an email verification has been sent to you, which is a link you need to click to complete your registration.
  - Click, and carry on. Now you want to click the button (left) for eSubscription. You might get sent to another page in which you have to choose eSubscription again (I know, it's the government, what do you expect). Once you get to the Subscription page, you'll have to enter **the current docket number. It is: PF15-1-000.**
  - You will then see a page indicating the docket number, and Penn East's pre-filing, and a button below that says "Subscribe".  
I had to do this a few times before the Subscribe button would take. In fact, I had to log out and back in and go through the process a second time to get it done.
  - Now, you are a subscriber and can make comments - PLEASE DO THIS!!!
