- Permits will be available at the Delaware Township Police Station, from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm, to be sold by Dee Higgins. Permits will be available starting September 21, 2020, Monday through Friday.

- Load your vehicle so that it can be easily unloaded. To move the line along, please separate any wood/lumber (NOT tree or shrub debris); also separate your electronics. These items will be unloaded outside of the gated area, and the unloading may be done by you.

DISCLAIMER: Any items that cannot be safely or easily unloaded will be left on your vehicle, see the attached information about what is allowed.

- Line up for Household Clean Up Day, **REMAIN in your car and please wear a mask.**

***Make sure you are in line by 12:00 p.m.***

- PLEASE understand that only 75 permits will be issued and that the event is open for almost six (6) hours. ***Please be patient if any lines occur.***

Passenger cars, NON-SUV	\$10.00
Mini-vans; smaller SUVs	\$20.00
Smaller pick-up trucks (up to two tons); larger SUVs	\$30.00
Larger pick-up trucks; oversized vans (in length, or height or width)	\$35.00
Trailer only, up to 12 feet in length with no side extensions +\$2.00 for each additional foot, up to 18 feet	\$40.00
Tire without rim (16" diameter maximum, limit 10 per family)	\$ 5.00

## Delaware Township Household Clean-up Days **2020** Pre-Registration Required

WHERE: Delaware Township Garage, 816 Sergeantsville Road (Route 523)

WHEN: 7 a.m to 12:30 p.m. on October 17, 2020

### HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

- 75 permits will be issued for each Clean-Up Day at the Township Police Station, Sergeantsville Road (Route 523), south of Sergeantsville. Call Dee Higgins, 609-397-3530, with questions.
- Permits will be available three weeks before each Clean Up Day. Proof of residency may be requested at the time of registration; please remember your license plate number.
- A new permit must be obtained for each Clean-Up Day.
- This permit must be presented at the Clean-Up Day before you will be allowed to unload your vehicle.
- ~~Vehicle unloading is the responsibility of the resident, although Township personnel will be available for assistance with heavy or bulky items.~~

RESIDENTS WILL REMAIN IN THEIR VEHICLES for October 17, 2020.

### ITEMS ACCEPTED INCLUDE, but not limited to:

- Air conditioners, dehumidifiers, refrigerators (with or without Freon), and propane tanks
- All types of metals
- The acceptance of building materials is limited to one half of a standard pick-up truck load and may not exceed four feet in length. (Please keep separate in your vehicle – you may be unloading these items.)
- Please place any small items in a container that will be dumped and returned to you. Cleaning up items singly takes too much time and may be left in your vehicle.
- Electronic Equipment, thanks to FREE acceptance by SAMR, Inc., Lakewood, NJ. (Please keep separate in your vehicle – you may be unloading these items.)

### ITEMS **NOT** ACCEPTED INCLUDE:

- Hazardous waste (gasoline, chemicals, explosives, etc.) – check County website for their dates
- Paint (water and/or oil based) – check Hunterdon County website for their dates

- Household garbage
- Animal carcasses
